✔ Prepare in Advance

- Have the *Bible Background Video* ready to view.
- Retrieve, review, and have ready the videos listed below (links are provided on this session's webpage).

✔ Group

Show the *Bible Background Video* followed by the “Princess Bride” and/or “Garbage Pail Kids” video clips, then use any or all of these questions to promote discussion:

- In what ways do these videos reflect or differ from the theme brought forth in the scriptures?
- What do you think is the most difficult challenge that your congregation faces?
- What assets do you think that your congregation has among its members that will best enable it to address that challenge, or other challenges, and how?
- What spiritual gift do you think your congregation needs most badly and why?
- In what ways does your congregation typically recognize and develop its members' gifts and how might it most effectively do so?

✔ React to This

Play the “Fairly Odd Parents” video clip then ask questions like:

- How does this video relate to the conversation we've had so far?
- What everyday people have been heroes to you and why?
- What are the characteristics of someone who is a true hero and how do you spot them?
- What is the most heroic thing that the Spirit has moved you to do and how?
- In what ways do you think the Spirit is moving people to do other, less traditionally “heroic” things in your life?
- How can we better encourage people to let the Spirit move them to do great things?

✔ Close

Invite individuals to complete this sentence: “I most feel the Spirit when....” Close with a prayer that everyone can be filled with and gifted by the Spirit.
