✔ Prepare in Advance

- Have the *Bible Background Video* ready to view.
- Retrieve, review, and have ready the videos listed below (links are provided on this session's webpage).

✔ God Moments

Show the Bible background video followed by the “God” and/or “Optimus prime” video clips, then use any or all of these questions to promote discussion:

- At what points do the narratives in these videos reflect the scriptures?
- What do you think were the biggest turning points in the history of your congregation and why?
- How do you think that groups of people are able to sense a great moment and embrace it?
- How do you think they deal with it when they miss the moment?
- What are the most significant moments in a person's life, as expressed through the way your congregation does things?
- What does your congregation do in order to help people better deal with important turning points in their lives?
- How might your congregation better do such things?

✔ React to This

Play the “Catch That Angel” and/or “Born to Be Unlucky” songs, stopping briefly after each for any comments, then ask questions like:

- What do you think these songs have to say about these scriptures?
- What did you want to be when you grew up, and how did that work out for you?
- How were you set on the life path that you are currently on, and how do you feel about that?
- About what event in your life do you tell the most stories and why?
- What advice might you give someone who has just undergone a potentially “major” life event?
- Going the other way with it, how has your faith changed gradually over the years and how do you think that the gradual changes you've been through

compare to the “big moments” that we have been talking about?

- There are people who struggle with faith because they've never experienced the kind of “big event” where everything changes that they believed they were supposed to have. How might you respond to someone who is struggling to find their calling because of this?

✔ Close

Invite people to share a story about a “big moment” that someone they know has had.

Close with a prayer that God will speak to the group in such a way as to transform their lives.
