- Do you think God ever changes, or does God always stay the same? Why?

Play the Donald Duck clip.

- How close do you think this clip portrays the biblical story? Why?
- How were you taught this story as a child? What are the "feel good" parts of this biblical story? Do you think this is really a kid friendly story? Why or why not?
- What are some details that we usually ignore when telling the story?
- What does the rainbow at the end signify? How does this make you feel?
- Read Genesis 9:8-17.
- Why did God decide to destroy the world? Do you think this is something a fair and just God would do? Why or why not?
- What promises did God make to humanity after the flood? Why would God choose to relate to humanity different after the flood?
- What was the purpose of the rainbow?
- Watch the *Bible Background Video* for this session.
- How would you answer Nikki's questions at the end of the video?
- Do you agree that God made changes in this text? Why or why not?

- Do you think we have a God who changes? Why or why not?
- Why do you think some are comforted by a God who never changes?
- Why might some receive comfort that God does change? Which would you consider yourself to be?
- If God were to change because of modern humanity, what would God change?
- What would be the reason God would choose to change?
